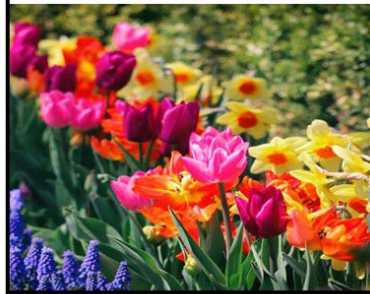
NELSON'S NEWS
